We are pleased to present the first solo exhibition of Sandra Meisel at galerie burster karlsruhe titled *Augenblicke gleich null, alles andere mehr*. The exhibition is presented in the context of the family-exhibition *What is here to keep me there?* with Eberhard Eckerle and Sophia Solaris shown at Galerie Knecht und Burster.

Sandra Meisel's sculptural works often refer to everyday design, industrial mass production and architectural functionality, combining organic and technical, banality and meaning. Meisel integrates found objects and recycled materials into installations that are based on the exhibition space showing minimal, very precise arrangements. Very often a surreal, almost dream-like aura surrounds them.

Meisel's installative spatial constructions are juxtaposed with a series of new photographic works – found pictorial material that she has photographed, digitally processed and colored. This process is based on the attempt to overcome the separation between viewer and object, object and subject as well as different time levels in order to achieve the greatest possible immediacy.

Sandra Meisel, born 1970 in Karlsruhe, lives and works in Berlin. She is a member of the artist group Der Strich. Her works have already been shown in several national and international solo exhibitions, including 2014 at the Goethe Institut Los Angeles.
