We are pleased to present the ninth edition of our SHOTS at galerie burster Berlin – SHOT# is a series of short exhibitions that provides a platform for experimental formats.

shot#nine (floating) brings together five talented emerging artists living in Berlin. The works in the exhibition range between figurative painting, photography, expansive installation and ceramics.

The exhibition offers space for powerful and tense works of young artists, whereby the different works evoke their intensity in their own unique way. In their interplay, the artists create a floating atmosphere that captivates us. Sometimes through a humorous and light-hearted approach, then again through an intimate and self-reflective way, or through an intensity that comes from an intellectually imbued creative process.

Together, these highly talented artists create an aesthetic space of experience through which we can roam.

Bella Bram (*1993 in Wetzlar, based in Berlin) graduated as a Meisterschüler:in from the Universität der Künste in 2023. Bram received the Ursula Hanke-Förster Prize for Sculpture in 2023. Their works have been shown at the Dorothea-Konwiarz-Stiftung, Daniel Marzona Galerie, Kunstraum Potsdamer Straße, Künstlerhaus Bethanien and galerie burster, Berlin.

Lunita-July Dorn (*1999 in Berlin, based in Berlin) has been studying painting at the Kunsthochschule Weißensee since 2020. Dorn is a scholarship holder of the Studienstiftung des deutschen Volkes and her works have been shown at the Zitadelle Spandau and the Galerie Judith Andreae, Bonn, among others.

Frank Jimin Hopp (*1994 in Berlin, lives in Berlin) graduated as a master student from the Universität der Künste in 2023. Hopp received the art award of the Haus am Kleistpark in 2019. In 2022 he was a

participating artist at documenta 15. He showed a solo exhibition at Galerie im Tempelhof Museum and participated in various group shows at PSM Gallery, XPINKY or Kang Contemporary in Berlin.

Bethan Hughes (*1989 in Wigan, UK, lives in Berlin) studied Fine Art in Glasgow and Media Art at Bauhaus University Weimar. In 2020 she received a PhD from the University of Leeds. Bethan Hughes was a fellow at Goldrausch in 2021 and received the research grant from the city of Berlin. Her work has been shown in solo exhibitions at feldfünf, Berlin, Centrum Berlin, and HAUNT/frontviews Berlin, and in group exhibitions at Künstlerhaus Sootbörn, Stiftung Künstlerdorf Schöppingen, Bankley Gallery, Manchester, UK, and Gallery 46, Whitechapel, London, UK, among others.

Emil Urbanek (*2000 in Berlin, based in Berlin) studies painting at the UdK in the class of Prof. Thomas Zipp since 2019. Their works have been shown at the Weserhalle Berlin, EIGEN+ART Lab, Galleria Alessandro Albanese, Milan at Bonner Kunstverein and Better Go South, Stuttgart, among others.
